- Manage projects relating to new product introduction, engineering release and transfers (by coordinating activities to achieve project goals and timelines)
- Verify drawing and bill of material accuracy to customer requirement
- Define and propose new or improved product designs for lower cost or higher performance including WEC content
- Act as primary technical contact on copper and fiber optic cable assembly opportunities
- Determine manufacturers and sources of components and identify any that can be sourced from within Winchester
- Work with suppliers and customers to determine equivalents or cross references if acceptable
- Create and process engineering requests relating to the above responsibilities

Requirements

- BS in Engineering or equivalent related experience
- 5+ years in copper or fiber cable assembly industry, customer interface a plus
- Experience in cable and electro-mechanical assembly
